Minutes of meeting January 19, 2023, via Zoom

Meeting called to order at 5:15pm

Members present: Nancy Davis, Rob Jones, Chris Nelson, Nancy Davis, Marci Ligammari, Grant Parks GM/Chair

Correspondence and Public Comments:

- Listener to Peace and Social Justice emailed Natalie Hanson and Robert Jones asking if PSJ ever offers opposing viewpoints on the program. Natalie replied, then Robert replied and looped in Grant.

ACTIONS TAKEN

- The PC voted unanimously to add Bryce Goldstein to the Peace and Social Justice team, first Fridays
- The PC voted unanimously to change the length of Peace and Social Justice from 90m to 60m starting February 3, 2023
- The PC voted unanimously to add Talk World Radio to the schedule, Fridays 11:30am–12:00pm

GM REPORT AND GENERAL DISCUSSION

Replacements for Ask Dr. Gayle and Imagining Community. Chris suggested that in the long term we look to fill those two spots with programming that increases diversity at the station, suggesting original programming found on Oroville community radio station KROV. Grant agreed. For now, Chris suggested Project Censored. Grant will add Project Censored for February. The PC will revisit the issue at the next PC meeting after Chris hears back from Tiffany from KROV.

Preserving the Public Affairs Archive. Chris is hiring Cory Hunt to remove unlicensed music from the PSJ archives.

North State Give and Take Name Change. Bobbi Tryon and Grant agreed to change the name of North State Give and Take to North State Local Voices. Robert raised concerns that for-profit guests might constitute a tacit endorsement of their business.

Comments on current programming

- Marci suggested that public affairs programmers be more vigilant about resetting the audience.
- Marci also suggested that the day/dates of events on the Community Calendar be read after the event is announced.

- Robert asked if there was an RIAA rule against playing a certain number of tracks from the same artist. Grant clarified that he believes that the restriction is about playing tracks from the same recording in the same order as found on the recording.
- Grant reported that some new, fresh voices have recently been certified as new programmers.
- Shirley inquired about precoded interviews with bands and the rules regarding announcing the details of the show versus calls to action. Grant clarified the difference between publicizing a show and an explicit call to action that directly encourages listeners to attend the show. Robert recommended Shirley look at the language on payola, plugola, and commercialism in the Programmer's Handbook.
